Sign the document in the presence of both witnesses. The witnesses are not entitled to read your Codicil, although they must be aware of the type of document they are witnessing.

Pass the Codicil to your witnesses for signature. Both witnesses must sign the document in front of you and in front of one another.





God is using our DPM outreach to ensure that the light of Jesus shines brightly in the lives of thousands of Christians like Pastor Asif all over the Middle East.

Pastor Asif runs an underground church in Iran and is desperate for good Bible teaching and spiritual encouragement. Our DPM workers in a neighbouring country are reaching out to Iranian pastors like him by inviting them to a week of training in God's Word and fellowship using Derek's materials.

Pastor Asif was greatly blessed by Derek's teaching and his eyes were filled with tears when our worker gave him a SD card filled with more of Derek's essential teaching that could help his church community to grow strong in their faith in the years to come.

Encouraging Christians worldwide to pray for Israel


Talking about the importance of making teaching about Israel available to Christians worldwide our Outreach Coordinator for Eastern Europe Branislav Čekan said: 'During the 25 years of my Christian walk I haven't heard much preaching or teaching on the subject of "Israel", "Jewish celebrations". "Jewish roots" etc.

Many Christians in Eastern Europe and elsewhere today would benefit from reading and hearing what Derek Prince taught about Israel. It will help them to see the connection between Jesus' second coming and the re-gathering of the Jews in Israel.

Also this teaching can address the deadly cancer of antisemitism that is spreading through many European countries with the rise of nationalistic movements that aim to twist the historical records of the Holocaust

Many Christians don't see how deadly this is. So hopefully this teaching will wake them up and inspire them to love Israel and to pray for its people.'

By remembering DPM in your will you can ensure that we continue to make Derek's teaching about Israel freely available in different languages so Christians in Eastern Europe and elsewhere can be inspired to pray effectively for Israel.



Since 1995, thanks to the generosity of supporters like you, thousands of inmates in UK prisons and detention centres have been challenged and blessed by Derek's Bible teaching made available to them through our ministry of Inside Outreach.

Recently we expanded this ministry by sending out a new resource guide to chaplains and prisoners containing a larger range of free Bible teaching resources.

Another welcome addition to our Inside Outreach activities is the provision of Derek's materials in foreign languages including Farsi, Arabic, Turkish, French and Russian for prisoners in the UK whose first language is not English.

Our hope and prayer is that God will use Derek's teaching to strengthen the faith of Christian inmates and to open the spiritual eyes of those who need the love, healing and forgiveness only He can offer.

How to include DPM in your will

If you are considering including a gift to DPM in your will, you should speak to your solicitor who can advise you about the right procedure and the benefits of different ways of including a charity in your will.

Here are some types of legacy gift you can leave:

A share of your estate. After you have provided for your loved ones, you can leave a share of what remains to charity. You can specify a percentage or share of your estate. This is known as a 'residuary gift'.

A cash gift. This is when you leave a specific sum of money to a charity. This is known as a 'pecuniary gift'.

A specific gift. If you wish to leave a certain valuable item to DPM you should consider adding it to your will as a specific legacy gift.

A gift in trust. You can leave a gift such as your home for someone to use until they reach a certain age, or for life. It can then be donated to other recipients, such as a charity.

At DPM we appreciate every legacy gift, regardless of size, and our promise to you is that we will honour your commitment to our work by being effective stewards of your contribution.

What to do next

- If you have already written your will and wish to include a charitable gift to DPM, you can speak to your solicitor. Or you can complete and sign the fully legal codicil form included in this pack and send it to your solicitor to keep alongside your original will.
- If you have not yet made a will, may we suggest that you speak to a solicitor in your area.
- If you have already included DPM in your will, or intend to, then you may choose to let us know so we can communicate with you in the best way.
